The following documents may be used as proof you live in New Jersey. This is not a comprehensive list, but categories of the most common types used by veterans and their eligible family. All documents used as proof you are living in New Jersey should include the student's name and current residential address.

- A current and valid New Jersey driver license or New Jersey state identification card.
- Any other official identification card or license issued by a New Jersey governmental body or unit.
- Any identification card issued by a New Jersey employer in the normal course of business and bearing a photo of the card holder, but not including a business card.
- A real estate tax bill or receipt for the current year or the year preceding the date of enrollment.
- On campus residential housing agreement
- A gas, electric, or telephone service statement (utility bill) for the period commencing no earlier than 90 days before the date of enrollment.
- Bank statement
- Paycheck
- A check or other document issued by a unit of government.
- Residential lease that is effective on date of registration.
- An affidavit on public or private social service agency letterhead identifying a homeless veteran, their spouse or child, and describing the individual's residence for purposes of attending Rutgers.
